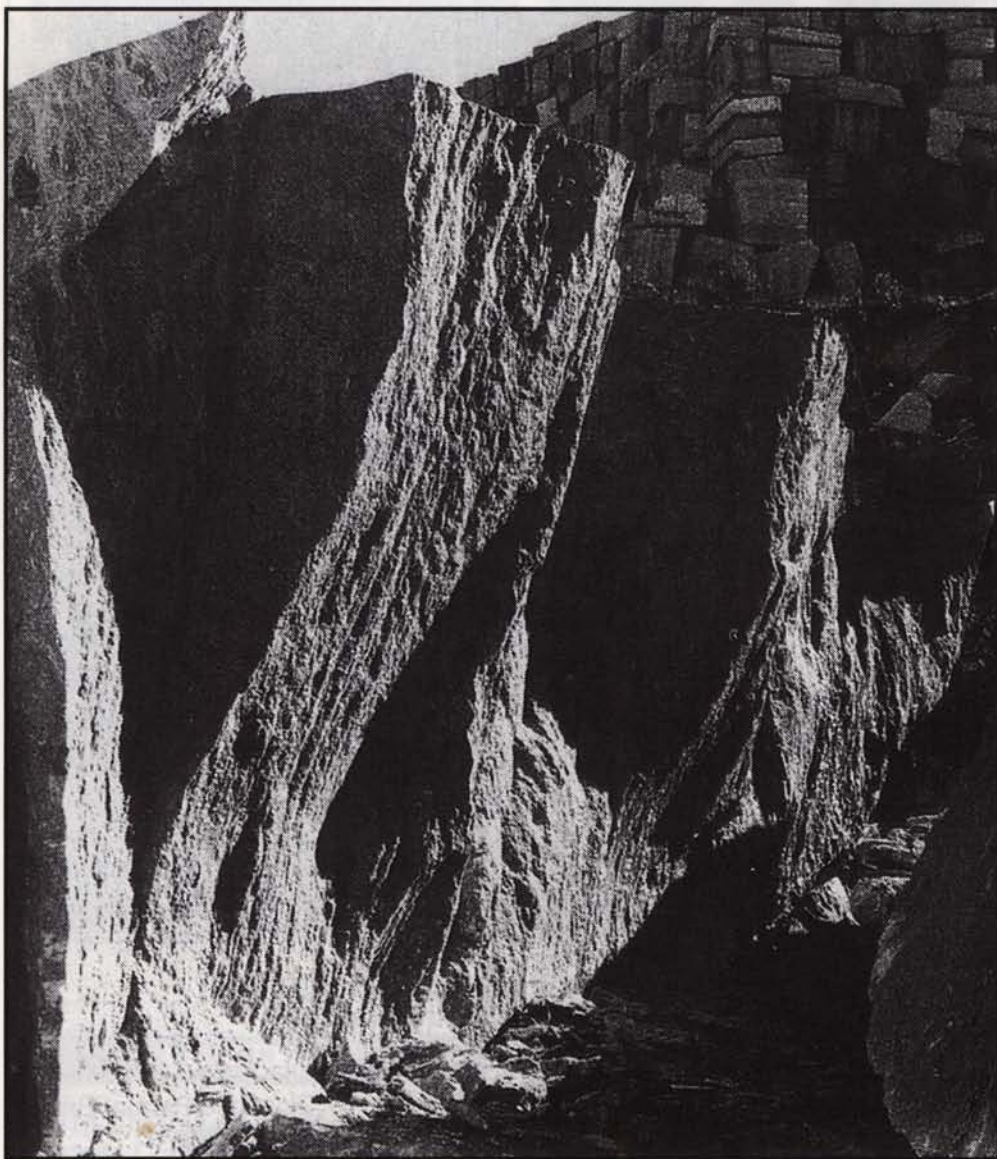
### \*\* ROME'S STONES

A.A.M.

Via del Vantaggio 12

Divided into three sections – 'Lapis Tiburtinus', 'The Stone Icon', 'Memory Graffiti' – the exhibition features numerous objects made by the European Institute of Design students in Rome, designs and sketches by thirty architects focusing the stone and the construction, as well as works by Rome's nine most important artists. The exhibition is also a contribution of ideas, reflections and projects on travertine marble, which has characterised this city's history and appearance. The works are also collected and gathered in a catalogue 'Sulla pietra di Roma' cured by Luciana Rattazzi (VI vol. of 'Interni di Progetto / Dettaglio').
