**A.A.M./COOP. ARCHITETTURA ARTE MODERNA**, Via del Vantaggio 12, tel. 3619151.

Corrado Levi's presentation of «The Extradordinary Experience of **Jean Carrau**».

**Victor Brauner**. The Rumanian artist's surrealist paintings from 1949-1960 are on display: a figurative world immersed in Brauner's dance macabre.

An exhibit of **DALI** etchings are also on view **Dino Benucci**, **Walter Falconi**, **Piero Tredici**! On display are works in a variety of media by these artists who work in Tuscany. Falconi's romantic/expressionistic works are juxtaposed with Benucci's dreamlike landscapes whose shadows harbor a bottomless abyss. Tredici's sensuous approach to forms shape gnarled roots of trees and, as it were, females in compositions of survival, physical and psychological.

**Attilio Steffanoni**. High contrast engravings by the Italian artist, who has been exhibiting since 1959, are reminiscent of photographic art.

**Mayo**. Egyptian-born artist Antoine Malliarakis' drawings and oil paintings from his Rome period (1966-present) are on display. Emblematic of 50 years of scintillating Paris life, Mayo's dream symbols still reflect his description during the 1920s in Montparnasse. American author Henry Miller said of Mayo then that he was «the eternal bohemian... carefree, reckless, floating on the stream of time like a leaf.»

**Valerio Adami**. Over 30 surrealist-Pop influenced mixed media works are on view by this young Italian artist. After Rome, the traveling show will move on to Venice's Palazzo Grassi in April, the Maeght Gallery in May and in October to Tokyo.

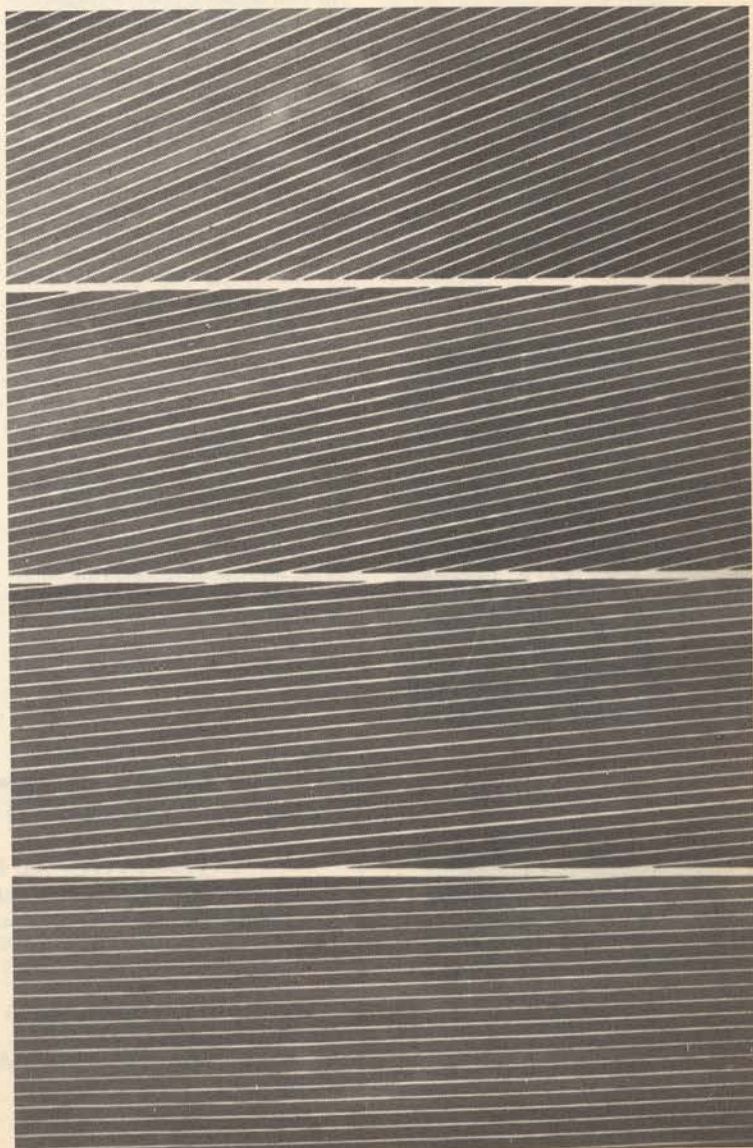
**Giovanni Omiccioli**. A retrospective.
