## FRANCESCO MOSCHINI

STARTING AGAIN

YET A NEW BEGINNING AFTER SO MANY

Francesco Moschini's lecture will be dedicated to retracing the diverse moments and real turning points he has faced during his career, starting from the recent conclusions he has reached after teaching over 30 years at the Polytechnic University of Bari to his cultural activities as Secretary General of the National Academy of San Luca in Rome.

Architect, former Professor of History at the Polytechnic University, Critic and Art & Architectural Historian, compulsive collector, bibliophile and librarian, he has always sought to meticulously expand his constellation of libraries. In addition, he is a cultural curator and organiser: he has not only worked in the private sphere by creating and founding A.A.M. Modern Art Architecture, which has been active and operational for over 40 years (all duly registered and returned, for over twenty years from the encyclopedic site www.ffmaam.it), but has also collaborated with various public institutions. During the lecture, the closing episodes of some temporal seasons of cultural commitment will be dealt with, including those in which Francesco Moschini personally had to restart and remodel his own experience/life vis-a-vis new cultural, professional and existential perspectives.
